Most prescribing of antipsychotics is unnecessary if appropriate support is available

- High quality ward, nursing and care home environment
- * Patient-centred care plans
- * Understanding of the patient's history



- Involvement of the patient (where possible), the patient's carer and/or family in deciding what treatment is best
- * Availability of appropriate activities
- * A medical assessment has been carried out to identify other treatable causes of symptoms:
 - * Pain
 - * IN fection
 - * Constipation
 - * H ydration
 - * M edication
 - * E nvironmental
