Creating the 'Last Days of Life Summary Page' for Consultation summary screen

- With Test Patient open go to consultation and click on [SUMMARY](#).
- Click on [CR CONFIG](#) (grey cogwheel in large blue ribbon).
- Select [Clinical View](#) from Organisation Options on left of Care Record Config box.
- In New Clinical View Box complete – Name “[Last Days of Life](#)”, tick ‘[Use Emis Library](#)’, search ‘[User3](#)’ and change View Status to ‘[Active](#)’.
- Select [Add Section](#) (green cross) on left panel and click on ‘[Code List](#)’
